COMPETITION RULES: According to FIE and IWFC

EQUIPMENT: According to FIE and IWFC

REFEREES: Delegations are required to assign a specific number of referees to officiate at tournament according to the following IWAS criteria:

- 1 to 3 fencers = No obligation
- 4 to 7 fencers = 1 referee
- More than 7 fencers = 2 referees

Referees have to stay for the overall competition. Delegations that do not provide a referee corresponding to above mentioned scale, will be financially penalized (€ 1000) for each referee.





ENTRY FEE:
(non-refundable)

For 1 night:	225 euro / person double room 250 euro / person single room
For 2 nights:	350 euro / person double room 440 euro / person single room
For 3 nights:	495 euro / person double room 645 euro / person single room
For 4 nights:	620 euro / person double room 830 euro / person single room
For 5 nights:	725 euro / person double room 995 euro / person single room

Entry Fee includes:

- Accommodation for the nights of your choice between 7th – 12nd March;
- All meals from dinner on your arrival day until breakfast on your departure day (served at your Hotel; lunch will be served at Competition Venue during the competition);
- Transportation between International Pisa Airport and the official Hotels;
- Transportation between the official Hotels and Competition Venue;
- Farewell dinner (on Friday)

Entry Fee does not include:

- The IWAS capitation fee.

CAPITATION FEE

The Entry Fee does not include the capitation fee of £ 40 for each participant. The capitation Fee will be collected by IWAS from the nations directly. IWAS will invoice the nations based on the number of entries of athletes, staff, team members, medical and administrative, once nations have registered and before the competition. Entry Process: only entries submitted with endorsement from IWAS National Member will be accepted.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY FEE PAYMENT: 3 FEBRUARY 2018

(LATE FEES will apply after this date: 20% penalty fee added to the regular fee)

Please note that for all payments received after 17 February 2018, there will be a 50% penalty fee added to the regular fee.

VERY IMPORTANT: WHEELCHAIRS AND WEAPONS CONTROL

National teams arriving on March 8th at the International Pisa airport, will do wheelchairs and weapons control in a dedicated room at the airport. From the airport, competition wheelchairs AND/OR fencing bags will be directly transported by the LOC at the competition venue .

National teams arriving by train or bus, and those who will come by private transports, will anyway be able to do wheelchair and weapon control at the hotels.
